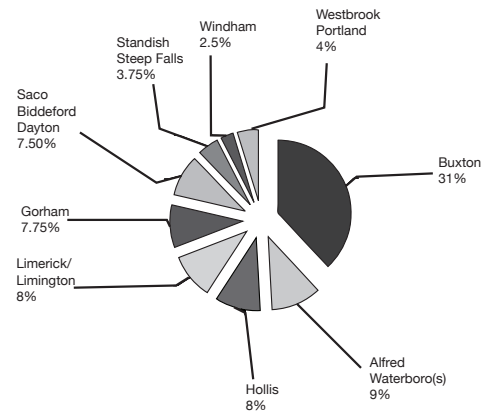

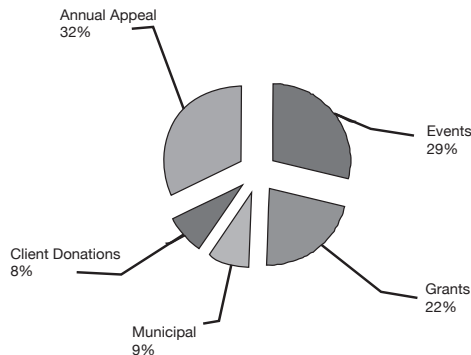

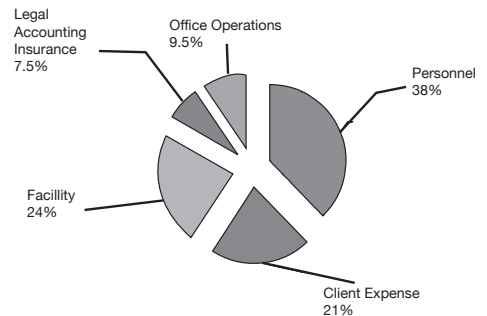
### Service by Town YE 6/30/09
